



## DISCOM1

The DISCOM1 is a high quality production mixer for discotheques and radio stations. D&R's immense experience gained in building thousands of mixing desks has gone into this exciting new workhorse.

All the basic features are here. The two balanced low noise microphone inputs have especially designed equalisation electronics to improve the clarity of the human voice. A gain control adjusts the incoming signal to the internal working level. The creation of a moving sound can be realized by means of the pan pot. This control can sweep the mic signal from left to right and visa versa. The p.f.l. switch displays the incoming microphone level in the master led bar. A smooth fader completes the mic running channels.On the back of this superb looking mixer there is an insert in/output socket to add effects to your sound such as reverb, echo, flanging, chorussing etc.

The extremely low noise disc inputs are carefully designed R.I.A.A. corrected input stages. With the gain control, sensitivity can be adjusted to match any cartridge on the market. By using the p.f.l. switch you can place the stylus in the first groove of a disc recording without interupting your performance (so that it is ready when you need it).

A great flexibility of the DISCOM1 lies in its phono inputs which can be switched to unbalanced microphone inputs, thus providing a 4 input microphone mixer together with 3 stereo tape inputs. These tape inputs have optimal sensitivity, low distortion and a genereous gain range.

To continue with the fantastic

To continue with the fantastic features of the DISCOM 1 we'll continue with its comprehensive master section. This production mixer has an extremely fast eleven segment peak reading led bar, indicating every spike so you can protect your power amps and/or your tape machine/deck. The outgoing signals can be equalized independently to correct for room acoustics. It's a high quality three band equalizer which can handle any acoustics. On the very right side of the mixer is the stereo monitoring section. With this stereo control you can pre-fade listen to every stereo input independently to adjust the incoming signals.

On the back of the console, which is suitable for mounting in professional 19" racks, are the cinch in/outputs which accept all incoming signal levels.

## SUMMARY

The DISCOM 1 has more facilities than any other discotheque mixer in its price range. The DISCOM 1 is very easy to service. For example, a fader can be replaced simply by the remove of two bolts. The name D&R is a quarantee of fine workmanship. The DISCOM1 mixer will satisfy even the most demanding user.






